

List of external agencies for psychological assessment.

1. SHINE Children & Youth Services

Fees: \$2000, Unsubsidized. For subsidy it is mean-tested, will range from \$300 - \$1800 (depending on income-level). Waiting time will be around 4-6 months.

2. Dyslexia Association of Singapore (DAS)

Full psychological assessments are available for primary and secondary school children. The full assessment consists of:

1. Cognitive /IQ tests (measurement of child's intellectual functioning) and
2. Literacy tests (such as reading, writing and spelling).

It takes approximately 3 hours to complete the assessment. This excludes an interview with the parent(s) prior to the beginning of the assessment which would usually take about 30 to 45 minutes.

The concluding session will be held on a separate day after the assessment. The psychologist will explain the assessment results to the parent(s). A written report, carrying the details of the findings and recommendations will be made available to parents in about four weeks' time.

Fees:

The cost of assessments ranges from S\$800 to S\$2800 depending on

1. Areas of investigation
2. Qualifications of psychologists.

3. Type of service (fast-tracked vs standard)

The cost of S\$800 to S\$2800 does not include GST and non-refundable admin fee of \$53.50.

Subsidy is available, and dependent on income-level.

Our current average wait time is approximately [^]4 to 6 weeks. However, if you require an urgent assessment, you may want to consider our Fast-Tracked assessment service that is offered to clients who request for the assessments and/or reports to be expedited (processed within 80% of current wait time). The service can be activated immediately upon receipt of completed Main Application Form**.

Fees: \$200 for subsidized patient and \$400 for private patient. Approach medical social worker if need assistance in applying for subsidy. Requires referral letter from psychologist or psychiatrist.
