- You are worried/upset because your results fall short of your expectations.



Joint Admission Exercise (JAE)

- Students who wish to apply to junior colleges (JC), Millennia Institute (MI), polytechnics and the Institute of Technical Education (ITE) may do so via the Joint Admissions Exercise (JAE) using their GCE O-Level examination results.
- Eligible school candidate will receive a digital copy of <u>Form A</u> via your registered email address from 2pm on Thursday, 11 January 2024.
- Eligible candidates can also download the copy of Form A
 (Form A comprises of the gross aggregate score for JC, MI, poly, ITE aggregate types and courses you are eligible for)

If you are eligible for JAE, the same email will include Form A which has: Your gross aggregate scores for JC, MI, polytechnic and ITE aggregate types. The courses that you are eligible to apply in the JAE. 6 calendar days starting from the day of the O-Level results release **Apply** Before the JAE application period, apply for a Singpass. You can only submit your application through the JAE-IS using Singpass. JAE PIN will no longer be issued to access The JAE application starts from 4pm on Thursday, 11 January 2024 and ends at 4pm on Tuesday, 16 January 2024. During this period, you must submit your application through the JAE-IS (24-hour availability). How to apply.



- You can only appeal for the results to be reviewed but are not allowed to view the scripts.



Release of JAE Posting Results

1 February 2024, Thursday

Mode of receiving the posting results of JAE application:

- (a) SMS to Singapore mobile phone number provided by applicant during registration
- (b) JAE-IS, which is accessible through the JAE website

First Day of Reporting at Junior College/ Millennia Institute

Date: 2 February 2024, Friday

• If you are unable to report to your posted JC/MI on the first day of school due to a valid reason, contact your posted school directly to confirm you are taking up the place. The school will reserve the place for you

Junior College/ Millennia Institute

- JCs and MI offer a variety of subjects and different subject combinations. They may also set their own school-based criteria for subjects offered, based on professional and student-centric considerations.
- Posting to an Arts, Science or Commerce course does not guarantee that students will be able to offer their preferred subject combinations. Students should check the website of the respective JCs and MI for more details on the subject combinations offered in the Arts, Science and Commerce courses and school-based criteria for subjects offered.

Applicants posted to Poly/ITE

Will receive an email or package via email on the enrolment details by end-February 2024

Direct School Admission (DSA) - JCs

Students who had accepted offers through 2023

Direct School Admission – Junior Colleges (DSA – JC)

will be admitted to their chosen JC if you have met the eligibility criteria based on your GCE O-level results

DSA-JC

- Students admitted to a JC through DSA-JC <u>will not be eligible</u> to participate in the JAE
- If you do not meet the JC admission criteria, you may take part in the JAE to apply for other course that you are eligible for

Early Admission Exercise (EAE) - Polytechnics

Students who had earlier accepted conditional offers to a polytechnic course through the Polytechnic Early Admission Exercise (EAE) in 2023 will have their offers confirmed and will not be eligible to participate in the JAE, if you meet the following criteria:

Criteria for EAE Poly

- Net ELR2B2 score of 26 points or lower for the GCE O-level examination and
- Minimum entry requirements for the respective polytechnic courses

Except for nursing courses – requires ELR2B2 aggregate of 28 points or lower

Early Admission Exercise (EAE) - ITE

- Students who had earlier accepted conditional offers to an ITE course through the ITE EAE in 2023 and have your offers confirmed based on the GCE O-level examination results will not be eligible to participate in the JAE.
- Your EAE offer is confirmed, and you must meet the Minimum Entry Requirements for the course

Progression pathways for Sec 4 Normal (Academic) students

 Secondary 4 Normal (Academic) NA students who have sat for GCE O-level subjects in 2023 can use your GCE O-level results for these subjects to apply for a place in the Polytechnic Foundation Programme (PFP) and Direct-Entry-Scheme to Polytechnic Programme (DPP)

Polytechnic Foundation Programme (PFP)

- An alternative to Sec 5 N(A) year.
- One-year foundation programme at the polytechnics that offers a practice-oriented approach to prepare students for entry into the relevant diploma course.

Polytechnic Foundation Programme (PFP) Eligibility

- Obtain a <u>raw ELMAB3</u> aggregate of 12 points or lower (raw ELMAB3 raw ELMAB3 aggregate comprises of EL, Maths and 3 other best subjects (including one relevant subject) and <u>excludes CCA</u>. CCA bonus points are taken into account during posting
- Meet the subject-specific requirement for the chosen course



From the Academic year of 2024 intake, the minimum subject grades for the two 'Best' subjects will be relaxed from N(A) Level grade 3 to Grade 4.

PFP for students who took the GCE O-level subject

PFP-eligible students will receive **Form P** with a unique password to submit the application via PFP website.

- Please note that <u>you must</u> meet the eligibility of PFP: subject grade and aggregate
- Being eligible to apply for the PFP does not guarantee placement.
- Appealing for PFP will not be successful (if you do not meet the eligibility criteria for both the aggregate points and subject grade. You should receive Form P to apply for a course)

Deadline – to accept, reject, or appeal for a change of course: **26 January 2024 (Friday)**

Direct-Entry-Scheme to Polytechnic Programme (DPP)

 Prepares students for progression into selected polytechnic courses via a two-year *Higher Nitec* course at ITE

Eligibility:

- ELMAB3 of 19 points or lower
- Meet the subject-specific requirements for the chosen course

Direct-Entry-Scheme to Polytechnic Programme (DPP)

 Eligible Secondary 4(NA) students may submit your DPP application online via the DPP application portal.

DPP posting results for applications made under the <u>final application phase</u> will be released on <u>18 Jan 2024 (Thurs)</u>, <u>9am</u> through the DPP application portal

Student will be required to indicate if they wish to accept or reject the DPP offer by 22 Jan 2024 (Mon), 11.59pm

Successful PFP and/or DPP applicants

- Students who have been offered a place in the DPP under the final application phase <u>should report to ITE on 22 Jan 2024</u>
 (Mon) upon acceptance of their DPP course offer.
- Last day of school for Secondary 5 students who have accepted a place in the PFP will be on 26 Jan 2024 (Fri).
- Students will be informed by the respective polytechnic on the enrolment dates for PFP.

Successful PFP and/or DPP applicants

- Students who have accepted a place in the earlier phase of the DPP in December but decide to take up a PFP offer now must withdraw from the DPP first.
- DPP-enrolled students to <u>check with ITE course advisor</u> for more details on DPP withdrawal process and deadlines for withdrawal.


